***Special reopening performance by Kellie Fuller and the Mike Greensill Trio***

**October 5, 2021, Napa, CA** -- Blue Note Napa celebrates its reopening with a special performance by Bay Area vocalist and Napa resident Kellie Fuller and the Mike Greensill Trio on Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 7:00pm. Blue Note Napa has been shuttered since March 2020, staging outdoor performances at the Charles Krug winery in the interim. This special reopening performance by Fuller and Greensill marks the return of live performances at the iconic club, located at 1030 Main Street on the first floor of the Napa Valley Opera House in historic downtown Napa.

"We couldn't be more pleased to have Kellie back on the Blue Note Stage as we reopen," stated Ken Tesler, founder, Blue Note Napa. "Kellie is one of our favorite performers, and she and Mike are the perfect act to celebrate our reopening as we thank the community for continuing to support not only Blue Note Napa, but live music in the Napa Valley."

Fuller will present a special evening of celebratory songs from the great American songbook, plus classic tunes spanning the decades, including memorable songs made famous by artists such as Dionne Warwick, Brasil 66, The Beatles, Barbra Streisand, Dusty Springfield and more - all with her own style and flair. Joining pianist Greensill will be Ruth Davies on bass and Mark Leeon drums/percussion.

Doors open at 6:00pm and dinner, wine, beer and cocktails are available throughout the evening.

Breaking through barriers, Kellie delivers wonderful surprises as she brings Jazz, Blues, R&B and The Great American Songbook to the stage with her own blend of humor, intimacy and energy.

Well known in his role as musical director to acclaimed vocalist Wesla Whitfield with whom he has recorded twenty albums, [Mike Greensill](#) has played for many venues and shows including Sedge Thomson's weekly Public Radio West Coast Live, San Francisco's The Razz Room and Society Café, and New York's Carnegie Hall and The Metropolitan Room.
